This info can be placed on a 3x5 or 4x6 card and it should be kept on the volunteer's person during the week. **Any potential health concerns (such as allergies requiring an Epi Pen or history of seizures, major surgery in the recent past, etc) should be discussed with the volunteer's POC prior to arrival** so that someone is aware of a potential health problem. POC's are responsible to check with the **parent(s) of minors** who are not traveling with a parent to make sure there is nothing we/their POC should be aware of. This is in no way meant to alarm anyone, just attempting to avoid a delay in helping to get appropriate treatment as soon as possible. We have had very few emergencies in the past and hope the Lord blesses us with another safe week!
